

SABO Treasurer Report (2017 – 18)

Attached to my report is a projection to the end of the fiscal year (June 30th) for the financials. I am projecting a surplus of \$1,152.46. This surplus is on revenues of \$34,165 and total expenses of \$33,012.46. With a closing cash balance of \$11,973.18.

The big initiative in 2017/18 was the Super Clinic held jointly in Saskatoon and Regina. The Super Clinic was funded by BSI, RABO and SBOA. I would personally like to thank these partners for providing financial backing for the betterment of our provincial association.

SABO had 177 Full Memberships in 2017/2018 and 57 Associate Memberships for a total of 234 Members for the 2017/18 season. In 2017/18 membership fees stayed the same. Due to the increase in the prior year we have been able to cover our fees to CABO and re-invest back events like the Super Clinic. I would like to thank the membership for their understanding and continued support.

Lastly, I will be stepping down as Treasurer of SABO. I would like to thank the executive I have worked with for the past 4 years. Their passion for officiating and improving our provincial officiating body is exemplary and should be commended. Also, I would like to personally thank Neil Donnelly for guiding SABO through the past few years as President. He has provided great leadership and steady hand.
